

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Helinox Camp Chair



Assembly instructions are printed on the reverse side of the seat – so you'll never lose them!



The easiest way to fit the lower part of the seat is to lay the chair on its back. Then use your body weight to help insert the poles into the lower seat pockets.



Place the legs and seat poles fully into the sockets and assemble the rear seat poles together.



Slide the rear poles into the pockets on the seat top.
Make sure the poles slide all the way in and don't get stuck on the line of stitching across the pocket (circled).



All done (thanks to our junior camper)!

Tip: the tote bag can be attached to the frame during assembly. Place the large loops on the ends of the bag over the lower seat poles before attaching the lower part of the seat.



Warning: This is a light chair. When empty it can easily blow away. When getting up, place something heavy on the seat for ballast.



Use caution when placing chair near a campfire. Sparks may damage the seat fabric and in windy conditions the chair may blow into the fire.
